

ELECTION INFORMATION

The Clerk's Office has received several inquiries about the Absentee Ballot process. Milton Township no longer maintains a Permanent Absentee *Voter Application* list. (Notice was sent out in July 2024).

State law allows you the option to join the Permanent Mail *Ballot* List and receive an AV ballot for every future election that you are eligible to vote in. If you join this list, you won't need to apply for a ballot for each election – it will be sent to you automatically.

(PLEASE NOTE: BALLOTS WILL NOT BE FORWARDED!)

If you want to vote an AV *ballot* in an election, you can submit an AV ballot application in any of the following ways:

- Request your clerk mail you an AV ballot application or download an AV ballot application from Michigan.gov/Elections, and return it by mail, email, or in person
- Submit an online AV ballot application at Michigan.gov/Vote
- Join the Permanent Mail Ballot List by marking the box on an AV ballot application "I want to vote absentee in all future elections. Automatically send me an absent voter ballot for every election."

It's important to update any change to your mailing address so you don't get removed from the permanent ballot list. **If we mail you a ballot and it gets returned to us as undeliverable, we automatically remove you from the permanent ballot list and you will need to re-join.**
